FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

New Jersey Conservation Stewardship Program NRCS Whether you are looking to improve grazing conditions, increase crop resiliency, or develop wildlife habitat, we can custom design a CSP plan to help you meet those goals.

<u>Fruit Guys Community Fund</u> Projects are funded to help farms operate more sustainably as well as strengthen community, including but not limited to conservation, soil health, pollinator health, food access, energy efficiency, beginning farmer support, and more.

Food Safety Certification for Specialty Crops Did your specialty crop operation recently incur on-farm food safety program expenses related to obtaining or renewing a food safety certification in calendar years 2022 or 2023? You may be eligible for financial assistance through USDA's Food Safety Certification for Specialty Crops Program (FSCSC).

Food Animal Concerns Trust Fund-A-Farmer Grant FACT awards competitive grants of up to \$3,000 to working, independent farmers located in the 50 United States and five major U.S. territories who raise beef cattle, bison, broiler chickens, dairy cows, ducks, geese, goats, laying hens, pigs, sheep and/or turkeys.

Organic Farming Research Foundation Are you an organic or transitioning farmer or rancher who wants to test out a new agricultural practice on your farm? OFRF's new Farmer-Led Trials program provides farmers with funding and technical assistance to investigate and learn about solutions to their most pressing production challenges.

NRCS Accelerated Funding for High Tunnels The USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) in New Jersey is now accepting applications for High Tunnels through the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) and Agricultural Management Assistance (AMA).

Farm and Ranch Stress Assistance Network (FRSAN). The long-term goal of the FRSAN projects is to establish a Farm and Ranch Stress Assistance Network that provides stress assistance programs to individuals who are engaged in farming, ranching, and other agriculture-related occupations on a regional basis.

<u>Safeguard NJ Wetlands</u> The Agricultural Conservation Easement Program (ACEP) helps landowners, land trusts, and other entities protect, restore, and enhance wetlands or protect working farms and ranches through conservation easements.

FSA Online Loan Application Home (usda.gov)

<u>Farmer Veteran Fellowship Fund</u>. The Fellowship Fund is a small grant program that provides direct assistance to veterans who are in their beginning years of farming or ranching. The application will remain open until February 14, with award announcements being made in May.
